


### **Period - January to December 2021**


#### **Pickleball**

#### **WORK COMPLETE IN 2021**

- Developed 9-year Stewardship Agreement with City
  - HCA maintain & operate the trail, support conservation activities
  - Collaboration with Friends of the Carp River
  - No additional funds; can apply for grants
  - Annual Stewardship Plan to be approved by City
- Mowed trail continuously in summer
- Installed signs to protect ski trail

#### WORK COMPLETE SINCE JAN 2022

- Stewardship Agreement signed Jan 2022
- Signs for species at risk birds (dogs on leash!)
- Built the world's longest snow worm
- Swept the field for obstacles to prep for clearing



#### **ACTIVITIES PLANNED REST IN 2022**

- Install City signs
- Remove/control invasive plants
- Bush hog field\* (volunteer?)
- Complete Environmental Stewardship Plan

# **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**CARP SOFTBALL/BALL DIAMONDS – GEOFF LATHEM 1/2



### Spring / Summer 2021

- Challenging times due to COVID.
- HCA's minor softball program didn't operate for 2nd consecutive year.
- Once restrictions lifted, some ball diamond rentals happened.
  - Greater Ottawa fastball league
  - Competitive Ladies
  - Ottawa Men's Senior Softball League
  - Ottawa University Women's team
  - Ottawa Baseball Association

- Thank you volunteers over 900 volunteer hours in past 2 years on diamonds. Plus, heavy equipment and materials donated from companies / individuals in community.
- Thank you to Carp Agricultural
   Society for their continuing support.

# **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**CARP SOFTBALL/BALL DIAMONDS – GEOFF LATHEM 2/2



### Planned Improvements - spring and summer of 2022.

- Continue improvements to ball diamonds.
- Diamond I Replace some fencing on 3rd baseline; Install netting between diamonds and on first base line; fixing announcer's booth behind home plate and fixing warning track.
- Diamond 2 Installing gate.

### Planned Activities – 2022 - Minor ball will be operational this year.

- Glen Cairn Men's League rented in June.
- Greater Ottawa Fastball League weekly games planned
- Two Competitive Ladies teams weekly games.
- Ottawa Men's Senior Softball League hosting weekend tournament in August.
- Co-ed adult fun night regular Thursday evenings.
- Men's Recreational Fastball League back after
   2-year hiatus.
- Men's under 23 Canadians will be played Aug 2 Aug 7. Expecting 10-12 teams from across Canada and around 10,000 spectators that week.

- Excellent ice conditions past season due to very cold temperatures AND
- Excellent ice maintenance by Warren Lathem, Joe Palsson, Dan Armstrong and Terry Boyd – Thank you!
- One serviceable snow blower this winter; ice cleared twice by contractor with tractor

- 57 of 62 days of green flag, 5 red flag days
- No winter thaw
- Ice no issues compared to previous winter due to solid frost in ground
- Plan purchase second snowblower this year to speed up clearing
