


#### **Pickleball**

- Ball Diamonds were well used again last year.
- Minor ball program another success year. The HCA hosted end of year tournament including a BBQ for all players and parents/fans.
- Thanks to Dan Kovacs for his help with the minor ball program.
- Glen Cairn Men's league booked Carp diamonds for their annual tournament last June and again this June.
- Adult mixed softball booked the diamonds again it seems to be getting more popular every year.
- Men's Tuesday night recreational league played throughout spring and summer. Concluded season with one-day tournament in September.

### DIRECTOR'S REPORT CARP SOFTBALL/BALL DIAMONDS — GEOFF LATHEM 2/3



- Carp diamonds hosted Men's U20 Canadians in August. Brought over 4000 spectators to our village. Nine teams from across Canada. Softball Canada very happy with our facilities. Our organizing committee has submitted a bid to host the 2026 Men's U20.
- Ottawa University women's softball team played all their home games in Carp last season. They hosted the Women's University Nationals in Carp - a 4-day event with teams from all over Canada. Many volunteers help us get the diamonds playable after the fair so the Women's nationals could be successful.

### DIRECTOR'S REPORT CARP SOFTBALL/BALL DIAMONDS — GEOFF LATHEM 3/3



- Upgrades to Diamond 2- installed gate on the 3rd base line; another gate for right field outfield fence
   helps us access diamond and us and the Carp Agricultural Society at Carp Fair time.
- With the help of local carpentry business Boyd/Howie Carpentry, we finalised the scoreboard we installed two years ago. Built deck around it and created a spot where scoring volunteers can sit out of the sun. It looks fantastic and have had many compliments.
- The diamond here at Craig Side Road was built in the mid 90's by volunteers has been restored and upgraded by the Kanata Baseball Association and the City of Ottawa. Kanata baseball committed to using this diamond for a min of 32 hours a week with at least 4-5 tournaments booked for this year. The HCA is thrilled that this diamond will be once again be used for baseball and that people of all ages will get to enjoy this facility.

### DIRECTOR'S REPORT HUNTLEY COMMUNITY CENTRE — GEOFF FALLS





- HCC is available for a variety of events and is a year-round multi-use facility. Cost to rent:
- Event with use of kitchen = \$40 for 3hrs or \$80 per day
- HCC building and outdoor rink pad = \$50 for 3hrs or \$100 per day
- Winter ice rink only = \$30 per hour or \$120 per day
- We have had an increase in rental use from previous year of 25%
- 6 week City of Ottawa run summer camp was held daily at the HCC from July to August.
- Canteen operation returned and was successful being opened for 2 baseball tournaments in 2024. Goal for 2025 would be to continue operations for ball tournaments and sport events. Always looking for student volunteers to help run the canteen.
